HEIRLOOM & OPEN-POLLINATED TOMATOES

Valencia – Heirloom. 8 – 10 Oz. fruits with meaty interior, few seeds. Farmer favorite! Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 76 days.

German Johnson – Heirloom. Vigorous, higheryielding, Brandywine type tomato with regular leaves (not potato-leaved). Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 75 days.

Moskvich – Heirloom. One of the earliest of tomatoes, deep red, cold-tolerant. 4-6oz. Semi-determinate. Days to maturity: 60 days.

Rose de Berne – Heirloom, 10 oz. round fruits great for slicing. Deep pink. Meaty & flavorful. Indeterminate. Days to maturity:78 days.

Gill's All Purpose – Open-pollinated. Good yields of 3" round, red fruit with firm texture that are delicious for fresh eating & good for canning. Disease resistant plants yield well late into the season. Semi-determinate. Days to maturity: 65-70 days

Rutgers – Open-pollinated. Outstanding slicing, cooking and canning tomato. Medium-size. The original Campbell's Soup tomato. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 75 days.

Peacevine Cherry – Open-pollinated. Dehybridized from Sweet 100. Prolific 1" cherries, Crack resistant. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 78 days.

Striped German – Heirloom. Ribbed yellow & red-shaded. Beautiful with complex, fruity flavor. 12+ oz. medium-large fruit. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 78 days.

Legend – Open-pollinated. Early full-sized slicing tomato with a balance of sweet & acid flavor. Great for containers! Resistant to late-blight. Determinate. Days to maturity: 68 days.

Black Cherry – Heirloom. Rich, sweet and complex flavor. Abundant producer. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Tommy Toe Cherry – Heirloom. Vigorous plants with hundreds of 1-1.5 inch cherries, unfazed by heat or humidity. Flavor is old-fashioned, full, complex. Originated in the Ozarks ~ 1900. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 75 days.

San Marzano Plum – Open-pollinated.
Classic Italian paste tomato. Heavy yields. Few seeds.
Indeterminate. 80 days..

Cherokee Purple - Heirloom. Averaging 10–13 oz, Brownish-purple with dark green shoulders and brick-red flesh. Rich Brandywine flavor. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 77 days.

Black Prince - Heirloom. From Irkutsk. Iridescent 5–7 oz garnet-colored globe-shaped fruits. Flavor similar to that of Black Krim, but without Krim's fragility and tendency to crack. Heavy yielding. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 75 days.

Ararat Flame – Open-pollinated. Heavy yields, medium-sized, deep red 6-8 oz fruit with some ribbing. Rich tomato flavor from Mt. Ararat, Armenia. Semi-determinate. Days to maturity: 60 days.

Starfire – Open-pollinated. Vigorous, bushy plants with a concentrated yield of these fiery red globes. Determinate. Days to maturity: 70 days.

Sweetie – Open-pollinated. High yielding 1" cherry tomato clusters for popping right into your mouth. Firm texture. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Carbon – Heirloom. Delicious, highly productive. 10-14 oz. fruit with dark olive shoulders fading into deep red. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 76 days.

Oregon Spring – Medium-size, early, cold-tolerant. Compact determinant. Days to maturity: 60 days.

Brandywine – Heirloom. Deep pink skin and smooth, red flesh with a rich, spicy flavor. Potato-leafed indeterminate. Days to maturity: 78 days.

Pink Berkeley Tie Dye – Open-pollinated. Dark pink with green striping. Sweet, complex flavor. Compact indeterminate. Days to maturity: 70 days.

VARIETIES NEW TO US



Striped Cavern – Open-pollinated. Red and gold striped, shaped like a bell pepper. With a hollow cavity great for stuffing with a salad or other fillings. Days to maturity: 75 days.

Tropical Sunset – Open-pollinated. Cherry tomato with gold and rosy red streaks.

Indeterminant. Days to maturity: 65 days.



Gardener's Sweetheart – Open-pollinated. Heart-shaped cherry with firm texture and lovely sweetness. Vigorous plants produce long trusses of split-resistant fruit. Indeterminant. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Golden Delight – Open-pollinated. Heavy, early set of small-medium golden yellow fruits that are mild and low acid. Determinant. Days to maturity: 70 days.

ADDITIONAL TOMATO FAVORITES

Honey Bunch Grape – Hybrid. Red grape tomato. Holds very well on the vine and is crack resistant. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 45 days.

Sun Gold Cherry – Hybrid. Without Sun Gold there is no summer. Deep sweetness with a hint of acid. Ripens early and produces until frost. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 57 days.

Damsel – Hybrid. Excellent flavor and late blight resistance. 8-12 oz. pink slicer. Compact indeterminate. Days to maturity: 73 days.

Plum Regal – Hybrid. A productive, small plum with late blight resistance. Days to maturity: 75 days.

Jet Star – Hybrid. Consistent, high-yielding plants. Fruits rarely crack and have outstanding flavor. Compact indeterminate. Days to maturity: 72 days.

Valentine – Hybrid. Vivid red, high yielding, delicious, red grape tomato! Resistant to Early Blight. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 55 days.

Little Napoli – Hybrid. A small Roma-style tomato that likes to grow in a pot or container. Bright crimson, meaty, rich, and tangy. Determinate. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Red Torch – Hybrid. 2 inches long and 2 bites big. Fiery red fruit streaked with yellow and pointed like a flame. Indeterminate. Days to maturity: 60 days.

PEPPERS

Cubanelle - Open-pollinated, semi-sweet frying pepper. Wonderful raw in salads, too. Yellow-green fruits turn red. Days to maturity: 65 green, 80 red.

Jalafuego Jalapeño – Hybrid. Heavy set of midsized jalapeños. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Gilboa Orange Sweet – Hybrid. Plants produce excellent yields of brilliant orange bell peppers. Blocky, four-inch fruits, sweet and flavorful for salads, stuffing and more! Days to maturity: 66 days.

Apple Elongated Sweet – Open-pollinated. Elongated 4" fruits narrow to a point. Delicious fresh and roasted. Reliably productive in our cool northern summers. Days to maturity: 80 days.

Purple Beauty - Open-pollinated. Deep purple skin, bright green flesh. Early! Days to maturity: 55 days.

Escamillo – Hybrid. Large, golden yellow Bull's Horn type Italian pepper. Sweet fruits are 6"x 2". Days to maturity: 60 days green, 80 days yellow.

Hot Portugal – Open-pollinated. I call this one sweet & hot at the same time! Complex flavor and beautiful long, wavy pepper with an early maturity to red. Days to maturity: 64 days.

Carmen – Hybrid. Italian, Bull's Horn pepper. The sweetest pepper of all when red. Great grilling, roasting, and fresh. Days to maturity: 60 green, 80 red.

Lady Bell – Hybrid. Sweet, crunchy moderately thick walls goes from glossy green to bright red. Days to maturity: 71 days.

Cornito Giallo – Hybrid. Half-size version of sweet "Bull's Horn" (ex. Escamillo) Great grilling, roasting or fresh eating. Days to maturity: 55 green, 75 yellow.

Bulgarian Carrot Chile Pepper – Open-pollinated. Like a polished, florescent carrot, 2-3" peppers are very hot! Prolific, bearing clusters near to main stem. Days to maturity: 68 days.

Islander – Hybrid. Medium, thick-walled bell. Ripens from a lavender, to yellow & orange streaks, and finally to a deep, dark red. Good eating at all stages. Days to maturity: 56 lavender, 81 red.

Sweet Sunrise – Hybrid. Medium to large, blocky peppers with a sweet & fruity flavor. Days to maturity: 65 green, 85 yellow.

Buena Mulata Pepper – Heirloom. Beautiful cayenne ripens from purple to red. From early 1900s Black caterers in Baltimore & Philly. Days to maturity: 80 days.

Baron Poblano – Hybrid. Large-fruited Poblano, ideal for Chile rellenos. A special flavor all their own. Not hot when green. Their heat increases if allowed to turn red – and dried are called "anchos." Days to maturity: 65 green, 85 red.

Long Red Cayenne – Open-pollinated. Five-six inch pepper, ½" across. Prolific and hot. Days to maturity: 75 days.

EGGPLANTS

Dancer – Hybrid. Lavender, slender, Italiantype. High-yielding. Mild, non-bitter. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Orient Express - Hybrid. Dependable, tender, delicately-flavored. Asian-type. 8"-10" long x 2". Days to maturity: 58 days.

Nadia – Hybrid. Black Italian type.
Uniform, dark purple fruits are glossy and blemish free. Tall, sturdy plants can set fruit under cool conditions. Days to maturity: 67 days.

Rolandia – Hybrid - Large and early classic eggplant. Dark purple fruits reach 8 inches and up to 1.5 lbs. Spineless calyx makes harvest easy. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Orient Charm – Hybrid. Lavender, Asian type. Slender 8"-10" long and 1.5"-2.5" in diameter. Days to maturity: 65 days.

Beatrice – Hybrid. Medium-sized, round, bright violet, Italian-type. Days to maturity: 62 days.
